

## VICTORIA FALLS DAY TOURS

<p><b>Tour of the Falls</b> Pass the 'Big Tree' before walking through the Rainforest with a qualified guide who will share a brief history of the Falls as well as detailing the flora, fauna and other points of interest. The Falls themselves are truly an awe-inspiring experience.</p>	US\$18	Morning & Afternoon Daily 2 hour duration
<p><b>Tour of the Falls - Zambia</b> Transfer across the border (passports and visa (where required) must be presented) to the entrance of the Zambian Rainforest. A Zambian Guide will share some facts and history along the way. Marvel at the finest view of the Eastern Cataract and the Main Falls as well as the Boiling Pot where the river turns and heads down the Batoka Gorge. The Falls are the lowest around November and December on the Zambian side, so no water may be falling at all.</p>	US\$30	Morning & Afternoon Daily 2 hour duration
<p><b>Sundowner Cruise</b> A wonderful opportunity to see a variety of game and a variety of bird species. <p><b>Zambezi Royal Luxury Cruise</b> The Zambezi Royal Luxury Sunset Cruise offers a unique, intimate way to view the River with premium service. Spot a variety of game such as elephant, hippo and crocodiles as well a variety of bird species, whilst enjoying imported wines and spirits complimented by gourmet hot &amp; cold canapés.</p>	US\$55	Afternoon Summer 16h30 – 18h30 Winter 16h00 – 18h00 2 hours duration
<p><b>White Water Rafting on the Zambezi River</b> An adrenaline rush not to be missed. The walls of basalt rock that capture the mighty Zambezi form one of the great river corridors of the world. A steep walk into and out of the Batoka Gorge and with rapids officially defined as "Grade 5", clients should be reasonably fit for this activity. Includes lunch at the top of a gorge. Tipping is not compulsory, however as a guideline we suggest US\$10 per guest per day for a guide and US\$5 per guest per day for other staff. <p><b>Flying Fox</b> Take a running jump into thin air over the gorge chasm (200m wide and 120m deep) then soar horizontally through the air over the brilliant turmoil of the Zambezi below. Tipping is not compulsory, however as a guideline we suggest US\$10 per guest per day. Minimum age restriction of 6 years (parents will need to sign an indemnity).</p>	US\$37	Daily Duration 15 minutes

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<p><b>Bungi Jump</b> This is certainly no ordinary bungi jump - at 111 metres with the Falls thundering behind you and the river rushing below, the adrenaline rush is as wild as the river itself. Meet at the Day Activity Centre for the stroll to the Victoria Falls Bridge. Bring your passport as you will pass through the Zambian border. Minimum age restriction: 14 years &amp; maximum weight restriction: 140 kg</p>	US\$160	Daily 45 mins – 1 hour
<p><b>Adrenaline High Wire</b> Experience the ultimate adrenaline trio-thrill of the free falling gorge swing, the vertical flying fox and the breath taking zip line over the Zambezi River Gorge. Return transfers are included. Children under 16 must have a parent or legal guardian present to sign an indemnity on the child's behalf.</p>	US\$120	Half day
<p><b>The Boma Place of Eating</b> The Boma offers a unique Zimbabwean dining experience including traditional dancers, an interactive drumming show and mouth-watering dishes. This is a unique cultural experience with platters for starts, a buffet for the main meal &amp; dessert. (Excludes drinks). Transfers are included from Victoria Falls Hotels.</p>	US\$57	Every evening from 19h00
<p><b>13 Minute Helicopter Flight</b> Known as the 'Flight of Angels', the best way to appreciate the true splendour of the Victoria Falls is to view them from the air. Fly over the Victoria Falls in both directions, up the Zambezi River and back over the Zambezi National Park. 'Bubble shaped' windows are perfect for panoramic viewing and there are great photographic opportunities from all seats.</p>	US\$140	Daily 13 Minutes
<p><b>25 Minute Helicopter Flight</b> Known as the 'Flight of Angels', the best way to appreciate the true splendour of the Victoria Falls is to view them from the air. Fly over the Victoria Falls in both directions, continue over the Batoka Gorge, then up the Zambezi River and back over the Zambezi National Park. 'Bubble shaped' windows are perfect for panoramic viewing and there are great photographic opportunities from all seats.</p>	US\$265	Daily 25 Minutes
<p><b>Lunch at Lookout Café</b> Transfer to the Lookout Café, located 120 metres above the Zambezi River, overhanging the giant Batoka Gorge and looking onto the iconic Victoria Falls Bridge. The Lookout Café offers fresh, tasty daytime dining with unrivalled views. Includes a 2 course meal. Drinks are excluded.</p>	US\$36	Open daily from 10h00 to 19h00
<p><b>Full Day Chobe National Park</b> Chobe National Park is well known for its large herds of elephant that frequent the Chobe River, as well as a lions, leopard, buffalo and a host of antelopes. Early morning transfer to the Kazungula border. A morning cruise for game viewing along the Chobe River. Lunch will be enjoyed at a riverside hotel before boarding safari vehicles for an afternoon game drive through the Chobe National Park. As you will be crossing a border, a passport and where necessary, a visa to enter Botswana, are required.</p>	US\$148	Morning 11 hours

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
