

# Mauritius Travel Protocols

Get packing for your post-lockdown holiday with this handy Travel Guide!

In the “good old days” you just needed a passport and you were good to go on your holiday... now the most important travel document around is a Negative-PCR test!

## Mandatory requirement for entry to Mauritius:

### Vaccination

All clients (aged 18 and over) need to be fully vaccinated with an accepted vaccine. Refer to [www.mauritiusnow.com](http://www.mauritiusnow.com) for a list of accepted vaccines and required time frames. You will need to present your government issued vaccination card to the health officials.

### PCR tests

All passengers, including infants, require a negative PCR test taken within 72 hours of your departure from Johannesburg. Please check this link for information: [www.ampath.co.za/travellers-resources](http://www.ampath.co.za/travellers-resources). A test certificate should contain the name of the passenger (as per passport), name and address of the testing laboratory, type of test stated as PCR test, date of sampling and the result of the test.

### Travel Insurance

Travel insurance is mandatory and proof of health insurance (hard copy) which includes COVID 19 cover will be required on arrival in Mauritius. ### Health Forms

Print and fill out the passenger locator and health declaration forms prior to travel to hand to immigration authorities or fill in the electronic version, these are available on [www.mauritiusnow.com](http://www.mauritiusnow.com)

### On arrival at your hotel and during your stay

On arrival you will undergo an Antigen test, once a negative result has been received you will be free to move around the hotel. You are required to undergo an additional Antigen test on Day 5. The cost of the Antigen tests will be borne by the hotel with the exception of Sofitel Imperial, Shanti Maurice and InterContinental Mauritius who will charge guests MUR300 per test.

### PCR test for return to South Africa

Passengers travelling to South Africa need medical certificate of a negative Covid-19 PCR test result obtained within 72 hours prior to departure, from the date of examination, the hotel will facilitate this at a cost of approx. MUR2, 500. Please ensure that you contact guest relations to arrange your appointment shortly after your arrival at the hotel
