### Welcome to Victoria Falls

Locally known as 'Mosi-oa-Tunya', translating to the 'The Smoke That Thunders', Victoria Falls are deservedly one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World. Forming a natural border between Zambia and Zimbabwe, fed by the mighty Zambezi River, the Falls are a sight to behold!

The 100 metre vertical chasm spanning the full one and a half kilometre width of the river, creates the biggest curtain of falling water in the world and one of the most extraordinary displays of nature's might and magnificence. Despite the beauty of the Falls themselves, this region warrants the reputation as an adventure centre, offering a plethora of adrenaline-inducing activities both in and around the Falls. The best time for viewing the Falls is from July to October when the water levels are high but the mist has subsided, offering clearer views.


On arrival in Victoria Falls you will be greeted by some of the friendliest people in the world. The predominant religion is Christianity, with traditional beliefs in rural areas, and some Hindu. Muslim and Jewish minorities.

Victoria Falls is situated in a summer rainfall region. Instead of differentiating the climate according to the conventional spring/summer/ autumn/winter divide, locals consider there to be two distinct climates - the dry season and the wet season. The dry season begins in May and extends through autumn and winter into October. The early part of the dry season is a temperate time with daytime temperatures in the early 20°C range and the mercury often falling to single digit figures at night.

Visiting the Victoria Falls during the wet and dry seasons is a markedly different experience. In early summer, the water level in the Zambezi is at its lowest, and the spray from the Falls is least dense, allowing for more visibility and better photographic conditions. Low water levels mean that parts of the Falls dry up, particularly on the Zambian side, but this is when Devil's Pool is accessible. During late summer, when the Zambezi is pumping, the spray from the Falls is intense and any visitor to the rainforest can expect to be soaked.

### **DID YOU** KNOW?

- Victoria Falls is one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World
- The Victoria Falls Bridge was the dream and brainchild of Cecil John Rhodes. but he died before the bridge was completed.
- Because of the spray from the falls – the Rain Forest at Victoria Falls is the only place on earth that it rains 24 hours a day – 7 days a week.



Approximately 87 kilometres from Victoria Falls town, Imbabala is located on a 5000 acre concession, bordering the Chobe Forest Reserve and boasting 14 kilometers of private Zambezi river frontage.

The main lodge consists of a lounge, dining and bar area overlooking the swimming pool and a nearby waterhole. The nine individual thatched stone lodges, all with en-suite facilities, accommodate a maximum of 20 guests. There is no access to television at the lodge as you will be entertained by the sights and sounds of Africa in all her glory. There are no fences to prevent animal movement, so expect to see game and wonderful birdlife along the river bank as well as in and around the Lodge.

Imbabala's menus feature fresh, seasonal foods, with most of the salad ingredients and vegetables grown organically in the lodge's vegetable garden. Coffee, tea and rusks are on offer before the early morning game drive, followed by a full brunch on return to the lodge. High tea is served before the afternoon game drive or sunset cruise, followed by a delicious dinner (sometimes a bush dinner on the banks of the Zambezi River). 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### A'Zambezi River Lodge \*\*\*

A'Zambezi River Lodge is ideal for those who want to relax and unwind against the backdrop of nature whilst enjoying world class service. #### Sundowner Cruise

Enjoy finger snacks, beer, wine, local spirits and soft drinks as the sun sets behind the African skyline, whilst watching a variety of game and bird species.

#### Tour of the Falls

Walk through the rainforest; along the gorge to view the Falls – the sight, the sound, the smell – a truly an awe-inspiring experience. The lunar rainbow, seen only at full moon, is spectacular!

#### 13 Minute Helicopter Flight

Known as the 'Flight of Angels', the best way to appreciate the true splendour of the Victoria Falls is to view them from the air. Fly over the Victoria Falls in both directions, up the Zambezi River and back over the Zambezi National Park. 'Bubble shaped' windows are perfect for panoramic viewing and there are great photographic opportunities from all seats.

#### Flying Fox

Take a running jump into thin air over the gorge chasm – at 200 metres wide and 120 metres deep – then soar horizontally through the air over the brilliant turmoil of the Zambezi below.

#### Gorge Swing

Leap off the edge of the gorge, free falling for 70 metres before going into a 95 metres long pendulum type swing.

#### Lunch at Lookout Café

Located 120 metres above the Zambezi River, overhanging the giant Batoka Gorge and looking onto the iconic Victoria Falls Bridge. The Lookout Café offers fresh, tasty daytime dining with unrivalled views

#### The Boma Place of Eating

The Boma offers a unique Zimbabwean dining experience including traditional dancers, an interactive drumming show and mouth-watering dishes. This is a unique cultural experience with platters for starts, a buffet for the main meal & dessert. (Excludes drinks).
