Half	CIO	THB 930	<b>Bangkok City Orientation</b> This is an interesting orientation to one of the most historic quarters of Bangkok. Drive past Chinatown, walk in the Flower Market, pass by the Grand Palace, City Pillar, National Museum and Thammasat University before going to Khao San Road. We will also stop at a jewellery factory.	09:00 - 12:00 Morning Only Tue, Thu and Sat
Half	CIT	THB 1 180	<b>Bangkok City &amp; Temples</b> Visit three of the most impressive temples: Wat Trimit with its Golden Buddha; Wat Po with its massive Reclining Buddha and Wat Benjamaborpit - the Marble Temple.	08:00-11:00 or 13:00-16:00 Daily
Half	WAW	THB 2 250	<b>Bangkok's Waterways</b> Travel by long tailed speedboat on the picturesque Chao Phraya River and klongs (canals) of Thonburi, past the Temple of Dawn as well as the Royal Barge Museum.	08:00-11:00 or 13:00-16:00 Daily
Half	DAS	THB 1 820	<b>Damnoen Saduak Floating Market</b> Drive 110km west of Bangkok and take a boat ride through the canals to visit the floating market at Damnern Saduak. Also visit the Phra Pathom Chedi' which is the largest pagoda in Southeast Asia.	07:00-12:30 Morning Only Daily
Half	GRP	THB 1 600	<b>Grand Palace</b> Visit the Grand Palace, once a Royal Residence and home to the Emerald Buddha Temple.	08:00-11:30 or 13:00-16:30 Daily
Full	AYCR/ AYCGP	THB 2 340	<b>Ayuthaya by Cruise (by River Sun or Grand Pearl)</b> Visit the glorious ruins of this Ancient Capital of Ayuthaya, situated 90 Kms north of Bangkok. Also visit the "Bang-Pa-In" Summer Palace of King Rama IV with its charming mixture of Thai, Chinese and gothic architecture. International buffet lunch on board.	07:30-17:00 Daily
Full	RIKBT	THB 2 190	<b>River Kwai Tour incl. Boat &amp; Train Ride</b> Travel to Kanchanaburi- the location of the famous 'Bridge Over the River Kwai', and the 'Death Railway.' Visit the Thailand-Burma Railway Museum, the War Cemetery, then enjoy a scenic long-tail boat trip along Maeklong River to the famous Bridge.
